Verbs are doing words. They are sometimes called action words too. A verb states what a person, group or thing is doing. For example:

Pingu jumps.



Pinga plays.



Now, underline ten verbs in the text about Pingu and Pinga, like the example. Do not forget the verb, to be, (am, is, are) is also an important verb.

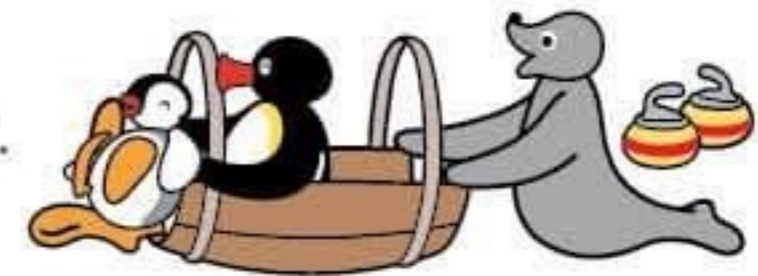
Pingu is happy. He plays with Robby.
